**SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:** Sacred Heart High School is one of the seven Diocesan Catholic High Schools in the Diocese of Camden. Sacred Heart serves the Cumberland County area but has students attending from nearby Atlantic, Gloucester, Salem and Cape May Counties. Current school enrollment (grades 9-12) is approximately 300. The program of instruction is College Preparatory, supplemented with Honors and Advanced Placement courses. The multicultural community surrounding Sacred Heart High School ranges from urban and suburban to rural and agricultural. Families sending their son/daughter to Sacred Heart High School are mostly middle class, whose parents often hold professional, managerial, and executive positions. Above all else, they highly value a Catholic Education.
