

SAT Prep Class Forming at SHHS

In response to the need of our students, there will be a 5 week SAT Prep Class offered this fall. This class is primarily targeted at Senior Students who need help improving their SAT scores on the upcoming October 4th, November 1st and December 6th SAT tests. This course is being designed to help students who are currently scoring under or just around the 500 point mark in either or both the Critical Reading and Math section. The goal is to help each student do his or her own personal best on these sections and hopeful move closer or go beyond the 1000 point mark. Each class will be limited to 12 participants so be sure to register as soon as possible. Please note that this course is not designed for higher SAT achieving senior students. There are other more appropriate SAT Prep courses and materials available to meet your needs. Contact SHHS Guidance for more information.

There will be a total of 9 classes, 4 Critical Reading, 4 Math and 1 Practice Test night.

The Class Schedule will be as follows:

Critical Reading Classes will be held on Tuesday Evenings from 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm on September 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th.

The Critical Reading Test Prep will focus on vocabulary, usage, comprehension skills, and reading strategies and will be taught by Mrs. Hartman.

Math Classes will be held on Wednesday Evenings from 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm on September 10th, 17th, 24th, Oct. 1st.

The Math Test Prep will primarily focused on reinforcement of basic mathematic principles such as decimals, fractions, percentages, deciphering word problems and an Algebra I and Geometry Review and will be taught by Mr. Dugan.

The Practice SAT Test Night will be on Monday Evening September 29th, from 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm. Just the Critical Reading and Math Sections will be administered. Results will be ready and discussed during the last scheduled class.

The Cost for the combination of the Critical Reading and the Math SAT Prep Classes including the Practice Test is \$200.00.

The Critical Reading Classes alone are \$125.00, which includes the Practice Test for both subject areas.

The Math Classes alone are \$125.00, which also will include the Practice Test for both subject areas.

Students must purchase a specific SAT PREP BOOK on the first night of class and then used each week during the course and can continue to be used on their own after the course concludes. The same book will be used for both Math and Critical Reading. This required book will be used in the actual classes as well as for weekly homework assignments. The cost of this book is an additional \$25.00 dollars due upon registration for the course.
