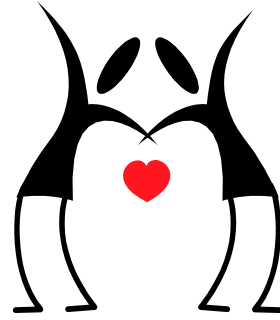


**SYLLABUS FOR HEALTH I
QUARTER CLASS
MRS. JAEP**



Purpose:

The purpose of this class is to educate students about Human Sexuality and encourage them to make moral and healthy decisions in regards to their mental, social and physical well-being.

Method:

Class will use assigned textbook, handouts that contain anatomical diagrams, lectures, class discussions, and films.

Assessment:

Students will be tested at the end of every chapter. The textbook consists of eight chapters. Students will be able to make corrections to their tests. Incorrect responses may be corrected on another sheet of paper and *handed in the following day*. Corrections will be marked at half point. (For example, if a student receives a 50 on a test. By turning in test corrections the following day this will allow the student an increase of 25 points in order to receive a passing grade of 75). Homework assignments are due the following day of class. Participation in class discussions and class preparedness are also considered as part of the student's overall grade.
