

Seniors not Participating in the Senior Trip

Participation in the Senior Trip is entirely voluntary, but students who wish to go to the Disney World Resorts at the time of the Senior Trip must do so as part of the Senior Trip and must comply with all rules and regulations associated with the Senior Trip. Private trips designed to coincide with the Senior Trip, but to avoid the restrictions placed on students as part of the school trip, are not permitted.

By choosing a Catholic high school, you benefit from the advantages of a Catholic education and also agree to abide by the principles that guide such an education. A Catholic education is concerned with the whole student – the spiritual, ethical, intellectual, physical, psychological and social dimensions. The integration of religious values into all aspects of one's life distinguishes the Catholic School from other schools. We do not focus solely on academic performance, but strive to foster the development of the whole person in the Catholic tradition. Behavior outside of the school can impact the school community.

No one who is not officially participating in the Senior Trip will be allowed to participate in any activity associated with the trip or to socialize with students who are participating in the Senior Trip. If a student arrives in the Disney World Resorts at the time of the Senior Trip, that student will be subject to disciplinary action. Any conduct or behavior that occurs during such a private trip, which the principal concludes is harmful to the good order and discipline of the school, its religious mission or its educational objectives, will be subject to additional disciplinary action. This includes: possession or drinking of alcoholic beverages, possession or use of controlled dangerous substances, being in a hotel room, suite, condominium, or similar place with one or more people of the opposite sex, disruption of the Senior Trip in any manner, fighting, public disturbances, being in an area restricted to those who are 21 years of age or older (*e.g.*, a bar), any illegal conduct, offensive language or gestures, disrespect to faculty, administrators, chaperones or fellow students.

Disciplinary action may include exclusion from senior class activities, suspension, probation, expulsion, and/or denial of graduation. If circumstances warrant, we will not hesitate to expel a senior and/or to deny a senior the privilege of graduating.

We also wish to make it absolutely clear that we take no responsibility for any student who is not officially registered and participating in the Senior Trip. The time and effort of the chaperones for the Senior Trip will be devoted to the students participating in the Senior Trip.
