United States History II is a continued study of our American history. ### **Student Grades will be based on variety of assignments:**

- ✎ Homework will be checked in class. Students will be scored on the completeness of their answers, and the concepts presented in the text book.
- ✎ Workbooks will receive a number score at the end of each quarter equivalent to a major assignment. Incomplete pages or work not done will detract from the grade.
- ✎ Quizzes and tests will measure vocabulary terms and material presented in class.
- ✎ Reports or projects will be assigned throughout the course of the year. Reports and projects will be graded according to the directions of the syllabus. The students will be graded on all such work by the quality of the material presented and proper format. Projects and written assignments will receive a percentile average. This average will be added into the quarter grade.
