On October 20, 2009, the Sacred Heart High School Chapter of the National Honor Society will induct its new members.

Membership in the National Honor Society is based upon excellence in four categories: scholarship, leadership, service and character. Each category is judged independently.

The faculty council selection committee is now reviewing all students who are academically eligible for membership. To be eligible for membership a student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5.

In addition to the academic requirement, students must possess character, demonstrate leadership, and show participation in school and community activities.

Please complete the forms enclosed with this letter and return them to the National Honor Society advisor along with two letters of recommendation, and a personal essay, no later than **Friday, September 25, 2009**. Please note: No *late* or *incomplete* applications will be considered.

After students become members of the National Honor Society, they are reviewed periodically by the faculty council and must maintain the high standards of the society. Active members in the National Honor Society are required to maintain a minimum scholastic average of 3.5 and live up to the character, leadership and service ideals of the National Honor Society.

Although you are to be commended for maintaining a high scholastic average, please understand that membership is not guaranteed to anyone. The faculty council makes the final decision for membership. If you have any questions regarding the National Honor Society or membership, please contact me.
