

Guidelines for French III and French IV

FRENCH III Course Summary

More intensive study of grammar is presented in each lesson. Grammar exercises are writing based. New and relevant vocabulary is introduced in lesson segments which include Culture, Journalism, and Literature. Students will learn vocabulary through association with other French related words and phrases. Students will practice speaking through study of brief conversations.

French IV Course Summary

Students will be studying the most important periods of French History and Civilization. They will be provided with a better understanding of French Culture and focus on events that have an effect on today's language. A grammar review will accompany each lesson with explanations given in French. There will also be study of current daily-used idioms and phrases.

1. Grading 50% Tests and Quizzes
50% Class Participation (includes independent work in classroom, homework, and projects).

2. Computer research will be used for some projects.

3. Conversational skits will be assigned on various topics.

4. Independent work is used as an assessment of the results of the lessons which are studied.

5. Copybook is required.
